**UNITED STATES MOTION FOR SCHEDULING CONFERENCE**

COMES NOW the United States, by and through its attorney, James C. Anderson, Assistant United States Attorney for the District of Wyoming, and respectfully requests that the Court set a scheduling conference so that the parties and the Court can discuss pending matters and schedule a mutually convenient trial setting.

1. On October 2, 2007, the Defendant in this matter pled guilty to *Possession of Child Pornography* in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2252A(a)(5)(B) and (b)(2).

2. The Defendant was scheduled to be sentenced on December 31, 2007. The sentencing hearing was continued several times over the next few months and the hearing was never held.

3. On April 3, 2008, the Defendant filed a notice with the court of his intention to withdraw his guilty plea, and on April 16, 2008, a hearing was held on that motion and since that time the court has had the matter under advisement.

4. On April 24, 2008, a hearing was held on the Defendant's motion for review of his detention. The court ordered that the Defendant remain detained.

5. On May 7, 2008, the Defendant filed a Notice to the Court of Filing the Declaration of Expert Tami Loehrs.

6. On June 4, 2008, the Defendant filed a motion requesting a trial setting.

7. On June 11, 2008, the Defendant filed a Motion for Expert Services Clarification of the Court's Order, and also on that date, filed a Motion in Limine to Preclude the Government from Showing Child Pornography to Jury.

8. On July 29, 2008, the Defendant filed a motion to dismiss the Indictment against him based on speedy trial issues.

WHEREFORE, the United States would request that the Court set a scheduling conference in order that the parties and the Court can discuss pending matters.
